## You will need:

- a toy
- plasticine
- paint brush
- pen/paint

## What to do:



1 Find a toy you want to transform.



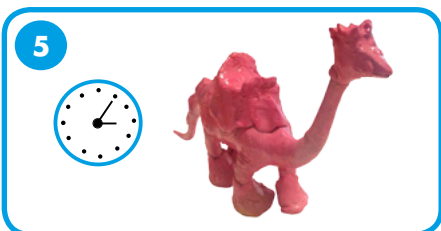
2 Take a ball of plasticine and use it to mold around your toy.



3 With your fingers pinch the plasticine to shape.



4 Use objects you find to add more detail to the plasticine.



5 Once you are happy with your sculpture let it dry so the plasticine turns hard and paint your sculpture.



6 Decorate your sculpture!
